Chinese-inspired decorations were fashionable at the time and reflected Europeans' fascination with the Orient and its influence on the decorative arts. A great lover of antiques, André Raynaud acquired an earthenware plate in 1974 whose designs he admired and decided to transpose them onto his delicate, fine, and transparent porcelain, allowing for a perfect and vibrant rendering of the designs and colors.
