### Description

Ideqqi pottery: double jar, unglazed terracotta, Maghreb, 20th century. Two chips are present on the necks (see photo). "Women in rural Maghreb societies, both potters and weavers, are the custodians of a culture and know-how passed down from generation to generation, but which is now tending to be lost due to rural exodus and economic development. The geometric motifs that adorn the pottery--which are also found on textiles and women's tattoos--carry symbolic meanings whose origins date back to the Neolithic period. The purity of the forms, the simplicity and spontaneity of the decoration give these objects a particular charm. They bear witness to a remarkable harmony between function, form, and decoration.
