### Description

Pair of Oval Medallion Portraits of Notables from the Late 19th Century. A rare pair of male portraits, painted in oil, dating from the late 19th/early 20th century (Belle Époque). These works depict two men from the European bourgeoisie or notables, shown in bust form in a restrained and elegant composition, characteristic of academic portraiture with a naturalistic tendency. The first portrait shows a bearded man, focused, holding a document, suggesting an intellectual, administrative, or institutional role. The second depicts a man in ceremonial attire, wearing a heraldic or honorary badge at his belt, probably linked to a civil, corporate, or associational office, attesting to his social status. Both paintings are presented in their original, perfectly matching oval giltwood frames,
