Description

Henri Callot (1875-1956) House at Ker Bossy - Île d'Yeu. Oil on panel, signed Henri Callot, depicting a scene of rural life typical of the Île d'Yeu, specifically located at Ker Bossy (location indicated on the back). The composition shows a whitewashed Vendée-style house with a weathered tile roof, opening onto a courtyard enlivened by stone walls, vegetation, and flowerpots. In the background, the sea is visible on the horizon, a recurring element in Callot's work, highlighting the close link between dwellings and the island's maritime landscape. The brushwork is lively and deliberate, with a luminous palette and a beautiful rendering of materials (stones, walls, ground), characteristic of Henri Callot's work when painting the Île d'Yeu.
