Elegant Wunderkammer composition with minerals and natural curiosities, Southern Italy

Eight small naturalistic specimens mounted on turned pedestals of ebonized and natural wood. The composition includes pink aragonite crystals, a natural shell, a sprig of white coral, and a fossilized shell, reflecting the encyclopedic taste typical of cabinets of curiosities and scientific collections on the Grand Tour.

Objects of this type were created as refined souvenirs for aristocratic travelers and scholars, combining scientific interest with decorative taste. They were conceived as naturalistic
