Saint Francis Of Assisi, 17th Century, On Oak Panel (antwerp Hands)

Description

This painting depicts a Franciscan saint, most likely Saint Francis of Assisi, shown in bust form, his arms crossed over his chest in an attitude of profound devotion. His melancholic gaze is directed towards a crucified Christ appearing in shadow on the left of the composition. The scene is rendered in a somber and introspective atmosphere, typical of post-Tridentine spiritual painting. The chiaroscuro highlights the expressiveness of the face, the delicate complexion, and the hands marked by a slight wound evoking the stigmata. Oil on oak panel, with the hand of Antwerp and the Antwerp Tower on the back. (See the Guild of Saint Luke, active in the 16th and 17th centuries.) Note some old restorations, repainting, and wear.
