Portrait of George IV (1762-1830), son of George III, King of England from 1821 to 1830, a contemporary of our King Louis XVIII, who, like him, waited a long time to ascend the throne, first as Prince of Wales and then as Regent, during his father's long illness. It is a handsome portrait, drawn to his advantage. The engraving is believed to be by Thomson after Nivetto. It is painted from gouache by a talented miniaturist, who did not sign it. It has its original, very dignified and high-quality lacquered solid wood frame. In good condition, with a barely visible trace of dampness on clothing. Portrait: 23cm x 19.5cm, frame: 35cm x 31.5cm.
