Antique Shoemaker's Foot Measuring Tape in solid boxwood and brass, signed by the renowned Ullathorne & Co. manufacturer, active in London and Paris in the 19th century. This precision instrument, essential for master shoemakers, was used to measure foot length and shoe lasts. The piece features two finely engraved measuring scales: one in Paris Points (a continental unit of $\frac{2}{3}$ of a cm) and the other in English shoe sizes. Its folding "sliding" mechanism with a brass slider is fully functional. The honey patina of the boxwood is superb, attesting to careful professional use.
