The curved spout is beautifully shaped for precise pouring, while the contrasting black handle, adds both visual refinement and practical insulation. The surface displays a soft, warm patina consistent with age, enhancing its authentic antique character. Subtle signs of use, light surface marks,

and gentle wear are visible, as expected on a piece of this period, and contribute to its charm rather than detract from it. The interior bears maker's and quality marks, confirming its silver-plated construction and 19th century origin.
