Oil on canvas, signed lower left, by Eugène Claude (1841-1923), a 19th-century French painter known for his refined still lifes and who exhibited regularly at the Paris Salon. This work depicts a still life with pomegranates, accompanied by a stoneware pot and a basin, a composition characteristic of the artist's work, highlighting the richness of the materials, the depth of the tones, and a subtly controlled light. The quality of execution, the large format, and the highly sought-after subject make this painting a powerful decorative work and representative of late 19th-century French academic painting. Some of his works have been exhibited at the Musée d'Orsay and are part of public collections. He regularly participated in the official Salons, won medals, and exhibited more than sixty works
