### Description

Exceptional pair of architectural door handles in solid bronze (or heavy cast brass), executed in a sculptural, organic modernist style characteristic of post-war European design.

The elongated backplates feature a flowing, tactile relief, while the generously shaped handles provide a strong, expressive presence.

The pieces are substantially heavy and deeply cast, indicating high-quality artisanal production, most likely commissioned for a specific architectural project rather than mass manufacture.

A hand-engraved monogram--a clearly formed "O" accompanied by a stylized secondary mark--is discreetly present on one handle, suggesting an atelier or designer's mark, a practice commonly found in bespoke architectural
