Two General stars are seen on the opposite side of the blade. To the backstrap is a gilt manufactures mark of "Berger Marchand Fourbisseur a Strasbourg". Consulate "etrier" style hilt design, showing a blackened and gilt finish with simple floral engraving. Original leather covered grip being wire bound and terminating with a large capstan pommel. Complete with its blackened steel scabbard, having two leather panels to either side and
