Ovoid vase "Nautilus", translucent glass body forming a gilt-brown mesh in bas-relief, hot-applied decoration of vertical, swirling volutes in iridescent green and gold glass with violet reflections, a band surrounding the opening in the same style. 20th century, circa 1904.

Johann Loetz Witwe (also known as Joh. Loetz Witwe and Joh. Lötz Witwe) was an art glassmaker based in Klostermühle (Klásterský Mlýn, now part of Rejstejn), in southwestern Bohemia, then in Austria-Hungary and later Czechoslovakia.
