This sumptuous mirror in giltwood, adorned with gold leaf, embodies the elegance of the Louis XV style, as revisited during the second half of the 19th century. Its beveled glass rests in a finely molded frame, enhanced by a garland of pearls that underscores its nobility. On either side, cascading garlands of carved flowers descend gracefully, evoking Rococo refinement and a pronounced taste for natural ornamentation. The large pediment immediately catches the eye: it is adorned with an imposing central shell, an emblem of the Louis XV style, skillfully framed by acanthus leaves, a classic symbol of abundance and majesty. This large oval mirror is a true decorative work of art, capable of transforming a room and adding a touch of splendor, worthy of bourgeois interiors or
