Its single drawer, subtly integrated into the front, is adorned with delicate moldings and punctuated by a brass knob, a nod to the metalwork of period furniture. Defined by a slight lip, it offers a secure space for storing precious objects, documents, or a tea service, while preserving the harmony of the table's silhouette. The tapered, square-sectioned legs express the geometric simplicity so characteristic of Louis XVI. The brass sabots, both protective and decorative, add a touch of brilliance that catches the light.
