A versatile piece, it integrates equally well into a Belle Époque interior or a contemporary setting, adding a touch of authenticity and timeless charm. company specialized in bentwood furniture. His son, Alexander Fischel, a former Thonet employee, played a key role in developing the designs, often inspired by Thonet's creations. After Alexander's death in 1895, the company was taken over by Ernst Hirsch, but retained the Fischel name, which had become synonymous with quality and elegance. ***** Period: Late 19th century.
