### Description

This oil on canvas by Reney depicts a tranquil rural scene: a rustic miller's house, its generous waterwheel occupying the right side of the facade, sits beside a calm stream. The river's surface captures the reflections of the vegetation and sky, while a winding dirt path leads from the foreground to the house. A woman's figure appears along this path, accompanied by chickens, providing a sense of grounding and human scale to the scene. The verdant hills and dense forest in the background enhance the peaceful atmosphere of this composition, bathed in the soft light of late afternoon. The painter has used shades of deep greens, earthy browns, and delicate yellows to create a harmonious palette, while the precise brushstrokes on the architecture and foliage contrast with the fluidity of the sky.
