This Indonesian kris boasts a beautiful blade, crafted using a forging technique with various metals to create a lovely decorative effect. The sheath is made of wood, and the handle is carved wood. It has a beautiful patina from use. This is a very fine kris dagger that symbolizes the dual physical and social nature of its owner; an identical model can be found in the collections of the Quai Branly Museum. Regarding its condition, please note that the tip of the blade is broken, as is the end of the sheath. There are also signs of wear from use and slight oxidation.
