Elegant lines and marble top. Very good condition. Hammered wrought iron base with a beautiful antique patina. A similar base model, but with a variation in the top, is featured in François Baudot's book "Gilbert Poillerat Maître Ferronnier" (Hazan edition, 1992), page 240, see last photo.
