Description

This Murano glass vase-sculpture, signed by master glassmaker Fabio Tagliapietra, is an emblematic work of contemporary glass art from the 1990s, where technical virtuosity meets a strong sense of artistic freedom. Made using traditional Murano techniques, the glass is enriched with gold leaf embedded within the material, creating a luminous and vibrant texture. The slightly crackled surface captures the light and lends it a precious, almost organic depth, while the colored glass applications--red, cobalt blue, aqua green, and black--are worked in relief with great mastery of technique. The piece is distinguished by its stylized face, with deliberately exaggerated features: an asymmetrical gaze, a graphic nose, and a smiling mouth with bold lines. The overall effect clearly

evokes a modern, Picasso-inspired aesthetic, where the human figure is deconstructed and then reinterpreted in a playful and expressive way. The dynamic and colorful undulating glass cap accentuates this impression of movement and spontaneity. Resting on a circular pedestal adorned with polychrome motifs, this vase transcends its utilitarian function to become a true sculpture. It embodies the spirit of Murano at the end of the 20th century: respect for tradition, formal audacity, and a dialogue between decorative and contemporary art. A striking decorative piece, this vase-sculpture is intended to be displayed as a centerpiece, immediately drawing the eye and bringing character, color, and sophistication to any interior, whether classic or resolutely modern.
