A beautiful Louis XVI style tiered cabinet, dating from the late 19th century, crafted from solid wood and mahogany veneer. It rests on four fluted, tapered legs terminating in brass sabots. The lower section features two drawers with original brass handles and keyhole escutcheons. The upper section has two glazed doors framed by gilt moldings, revealing an interior fitted with a shelf. Two drawers in the frieze complete the ensemble. The whole is highlighted by fine inlaid brass stringing, attesting to meticulous craftsmanship and quality workmanship. A well-proportioned, sound, and stable piece, retaining a beautiful antique patina. An elegant and decorative item, ideal for clients seeking classic furniture. It is made of solid wood and mahogany veneer, with genuine inlaid brass
