Description

This superb Louis XV style marquetry commode, crafted in mahogany during the first half of the 20th century, embodies the refinement and craftsmanship of French cabinetmaking. Its curved shape, typical of the Rococo style, is enhanced by finely chiseled bronze mounts and sabots, which accentuate the graceful curve of its legs. The drawers, with concealed crossbars, offer a clean and flowing facade, reinforced by a lock discreetly integrated into the top drawer. The bronze handles, adorned with acanthus leaves, add a touch of botanical and Baroque style, true to the decorative spirit of the 18th century. The richly sculpted central finial lends a note of majesty to the whole, while the griotte marble top, with its contrasting white veins, crowns the piece with brilliance and nobility. A truly
