### Description

The brass gallery, the finely chiseled bronze mounts and feet emphasize the nobility of its curved lines, typical of the revisited Louis XV style. This piece has benefited from the expertise of Lecomte Antiques, whose skilled work has given it an exceptional patina, revealing the full richness of its wood and the finesse of its marquetry.
