Description

Refined original 18th-century table, characterized by its elegant kidney-shaped top, typical of the late Baroque and pre-Neoclassical taste.

The top is finely veneered in precious woods, featuring a rich natural grain framed by a delicate perimeter inlay that enhances its shaped profile and attests to the high level of cabinetmaking craftsmanship of the period. The careful selection of woods and the precision of the inlay give the surface a refined chromatic and formal balance.

The structure rests on a central support with shaped uprights, enriched with carved elements and connected by stretchers, lending elegance and lightness to the overall design while ensuring solidity and harmonious proportions.

The table is in good condition, with a patina and light signs of age consistent with its period,
