Glass with a Double-Headed Eagle Russia, first half of the 18th century. Transparent glass; blown and engraved. Dimensions: Height 13.3 cm. Rim diameter 10.7 cm. A finely crafted glass featuring an engraved double-headed eagle, a key emblem of the Russian Empire. The depiction stylistically corresponds to the heraldic tradition of the early 18th century. The vessel is well preserved, showing only minor signs of use. Comparable examples are held in the collection of the State Hermitage Museum.
