Signed at the bottom left Francisque Gabillot is a French painter active at the end of the 19th and the beginning of the 20th century, mainly known for his landscapes and genre scenes, often inspired by rural life and riverside settings. His work is part of the tradition of naturalist and post-realist painting, inheriting the legacy of the Barbizon School and regional landscapists. He favors a faithful representation of nature, paying particular attention to atmospheres, light effects, and everyday life. On display at Galerie Courcelles Antiquités, 41 rue des Acacias, in the 17th arrondissement of Paris.
