A solid silver samovar in the Louis XVI style, shaped like an amphora with straight handles, flanked by two lions. The lid is adorned with a putto crowned with laurel, and the base is decorated with lion heads linked by a chain. The whole rests on claw feet and is surmounted by a non-original silver-plated burner. An exceptional centerpiece that will make a statement in any interior. This samovar bears the hallmarks of 1788/1789 and hallmarks from after the French Revolution. It is decorated with foliate borders, and its tap is also silver. Weight: 2.7 kg
