Large Pompeian-style bronze bowl with two handles - 19th century. An elegant decorative bowl in the Pompeian style, made of bronze, with two finely crafted side handles. The body is adorned with raised mascarons, inspired by classical antiquity, and rests on a well-proportioned fluted foot. This model is in the tradition of Grand Tour objects and is a decorative reduction of the famous Warwick Vase, highly prized in the 19th century by lovers of antique and neoclassical art. A quality piece, probably French, characteristic of the 19th century/Napoleon III period, demonstrating a pronounced taste for antiquity and Pompeian aesthetics. Period: 19th century.
