The movement of the cord adds volume, while the palmettes lend a light and airy aesthetic to the whole. These earrings exhibit only minute variations, indicating they were handcrafted, a testament to their exceptional quality. Their asymmetrical design gives them a distinct "direction" when worn, mirroring each other on either side of the face. They are fitted with clip-on systems for unpierced ears and can be adapted for pierced ears by adding posts in our workshop. The clip system's clasps are made of 18k yellow gold (750/°°, owl hallmark), ensuring perfect comfort. Estimated total diamond weight:
