Description

Cut crystal and silver ewer, Louis XV style, late 19th century, silversmith: Paul Canaux (active 1892-1912). This elegant late 19th-century ewer, crafted in the Louis XV style, combines high-quality cut crystal with a finely chased silver mount. The crystal body features remarkable helical twist cutting, enlivened by delicately engraved floral motifs, creating a particularly refined interplay of transparency and light. The thick, luminous crystal testifies to the meticulous craftsmanship characteristic of fine pieces from this period. The silver mount, made by the silversmith Paul Canaux, active between 1892 and 1912, is adorned with a rich rocaille decoration inspired by the Louis XV style: asymmetrical scrolls, shells, foliage, and elegant moldings. The ewer rests on a gracefully curved silver base, ensuring stability and harmony.
