Carved slingshot, monkey and amphibians, Guatemala, highlands. This carefully and skillfully carved slingshot depicts a monkey seated on a pillar with raised arms. Three amphibians in relief accompany the composition: one resting on the pillar behind, another positioned behind, and the third on its belly, its head facing the torso (see photos). Wood with an old patina; signs of use; traces of green pigment. Guatemala, highlands region. Dimensions: 14.5 × 3.6 cm. "In the highlands of Guatemala, the slingshot (honda) is an everyday object, used particularly to protect crops by scaring away birds.
