Description

The composition portrays a seated young woman absorbed in the reading of an open book. She is dressed in a flowing gown in turquoise and white hues, inspired by eighteenth-century fashion. The treatment of the textiles, executed with fluidity and precision, emphasizes the subtle play of folds and light. Set against a restrained background of soft green tones, articulated by fine vertical lines, the figure emerges with clarity and balance. Her relaxed posture and gentle expression contribute to a serene and intimate atmosphere. The work exemplifies an elegant figurative approach, characteristic of a refined decorative style, in which chromatic harmony and sensitivity to the subject are given prominence. Format 12 F
