The sculpture is attributed to a German workshop and reflects a celebrated model widely appreciated in Central European artistic traditions, particularly those inspired by Meissen figurative designs. The finely carved anatomical details, graceful wings, and the naturally aged patina of the ivory clearly attest to its age and skilled craftsmanship. The figure is mounted on an elegant circular ebonized wooden base, enhancing its visual presence and making it
