The body is entirely made of solid brass, featuring an openwork structure that reveals the technical complexity of the return springs and marking barrels. Notable details: With a height of 25 cm, this object has a strong visual presence, ideal for a display case or cabinet of curiosities. Handle: in turned and blackened fine wood (ebony-style finish), offering an ergonomic grip and an elegant aesthetic. Mechanics: System of exposed coil springs and
