Rare and elegant 20th-century (circa 1950) office date stamp in solid brass and turned wood, with a rotating date mechanism. This high-level administrative item is distinguished by its articulated frame structure, a design that is both industrial and refined. Unlike automatic models, this stamp is equipped with engraved brass handwheels, allowing for precise date setting. Mechanism: Pivoting system with locking mechanism via a knurled brass screw, allowing adjustment of the movable characters. The baluster handle is made of blackened fine wood (ebony style), typical of the aesthetic of Belle Époque executive offices. The characters on the handwheels (day, month, year) are still clear and well-preserved. Beautiful original condition with a smooth and functional mechanism. Shipping:
