The pure gold structure features glass paste elements in the shape of a half-moon and an inverted heart between two small rubies on the sides. Four bezoars hang suspended like pearls. An object of great esoteric fascination in absolutely exceptional condition. At the top is a cylindrical hanger for attaching a necklace or chain. The proposed date is between the 8th and 11th centuries. A museum-worthy piece of jewelry, of exceptional quality, integrity, and workmanship.
