Spectacular trees, forest atmospheres, places steeped in history, bewitching valleys, or even a landscape in its simplest form that it will know how to raise with a vital contrast.A discreet element in the life of the artist, Louis Cabié lived partly in Portets

around 1910/1930. Was he owner or tenant, difficult to answer today. Nevertheless several views of his garden exist and many landscapes on the banks of the Garonne are known. Our very luminous gouache, open in its center on the river and a beautiful blue sky, is not a typical composition for the painter. Particularly well constructed, this sheet from 1924 is part of the artist's last creative period. We are looking for any work or any information relating to the artist, in order to complete his biography as well as a catalog raisonné in progress.
