Royal blue and white peony vase in the taste of Ming porcelain, 19th century Qing period. A vase in tribute to the golden age of pre-modern Chinese porcelain. Creation from the ceramic artisans of the Qing period (1644-1912) at the end of the 19th century, this bottle vase is inspired by royal white and blue vases with a decoration of peonies from the Ming dynasty (1368-1644). Faithful reproduction, this vase is covered with floral motifs and notably peonies, imperial flowers symbol of luxury & prosperity that were in the imperial gardens. Its shape evokes that of a "bottle" although its use is to contain flowers, rather than to contain liquids.
