Pair of Art Deco multilayer glass vases with a colorful abstract marbled effect. The beauty of French polychrome blown glass in the colors of day and night. Entirely handmade by French craftsmanship, this pair of vases was mouth blown and then colored in the mass via the process of multilayer glass. Composed of two layers of superimposed glass, its organic form at the geometric base evokes that of Art Deco, pivotal period of design in Europe in the 20th century, between 1920 and 1939. Polychrome, its abstract and bright colors are poetic: its yellow-sun and its midnight blue blend into each other with a hint of orange, evoking the dawn in the morning, where the sun rises, gradually revealing the world, overcoming the blue of the night. Perfectly stable at their bases, this
