The piece rests on four saber legs with curved lines, ending in ball feet, giving it a balanced silhouette. The structure retains traces of old red lacquer, visible mainly in protected areas, adding a chromatic nuance and patina in keeping with its age. The overall visual presentation is understated and harmonious, without any alterations that could detract from the

piece's character. The rattan tabletop, with its even weave, is taut and perfectly integrated into the frame. The back finish of the weave, visible on the reverse, reveals an interesting assembly method, where the structure is secured with strong knotted cords. This functional and honest finish, typical of this type of furniture, prioritizes technique over ornamentation and reinforces the handcrafted character of the piece. Its proportions and character make it particularly well-suited as a center table or side table, capable of blending seamlessly into both classic interiors and contemporary spaces that value natural materials and pieces with a rich history.
