Oil on panel depicting a young peasant woman at needlework, a naturalistic genre scene. The work is signed and dated 1888 by Dehery, a student of the painter Pierre-Emmanuel Damoye, himself trained by Corot, Bonnat, and Daubigny, and a gold medalist at the 1889 Universal Exhibition. The painting bears a handwritten dedication "to my friend" addressed to Damoye, adding significant historical interest. Overall dimensions: 48.5 x 39 cm.
