Frame dimensions: H 38.2 x W 32 cm, image dimensions: H 34 x W 28 cm. Gabriel Griffon (1866-1938) was a French painter and sculptor from Toulouse, particularly renowned for his gallant scenes executed in a style similar to that of Monticelli, but with a lighter touch. He distinguished himself above all through his work in watercolor, a medium in which he developed a remarkable mastery of light, transparency, and subtle tones. His work consists mainly of genre scenes, elegant figures, and lively landscapes. Gabriel Griffon's works are primarily exhibited in Agen, in southwestern France. His house at 17
