



## Educational Set Of "breukenappels" (fraction Apples) - Critas, Doorn, Ca. 1920

### Description

Rare and complete original set of Breukenappels, a Dutch/German term literally meaning "fraction apples." These are refined historical teaching tools, used in the early decades of the 20th century for the visual and tactile teaching of mathematical fractions in schools. This piece is a first edition, produced around 1920, by Critas of Doorn. The set consists of nine apples, each internally divided differently to represent different fractions (halves, thirds, quarters, etc.). The apples are bright red and are made of wood and metal, with an ingenious internal system of folding iron rods that allows the parts to be separated and reassembled. The set is complete, preserved in its original condition, and includes the original box, a particularly rare item today. It is in excellent condition, with normal signs of
