It testifies to the revival of tapestry art in Aubusson during the 20th century, championed by talented local artists such as François Faureau (1902-1995), a native of the town. Artistic qualities: The scene depicts a lively rural harvest scene with a vivid narrative. The collective work around the winepress is highlighted by a rich composition where men, women, and children participate in the grape harvest, a symbol of abundance. The weaving is distinguished by a vibrant color palette, dominated by a
