Description

This impressive large oval mirror is a fine example of the Louis XVI style, dating from the Napoleon III period, circa the mid to late 19th century. The elegant giltwood frame is richly carved with classical motifs characteristic of the period, including finely detailed oak leaves, acorns, and floral garlands. At the crest, a decorative urn overflowing with flowers creates a strong architectural focal point, perfectly balanced by the delicate ornamentation running along the frame. The original mercury glass displays natural aging, with areas of foxing and subtle mercury "accidents".
