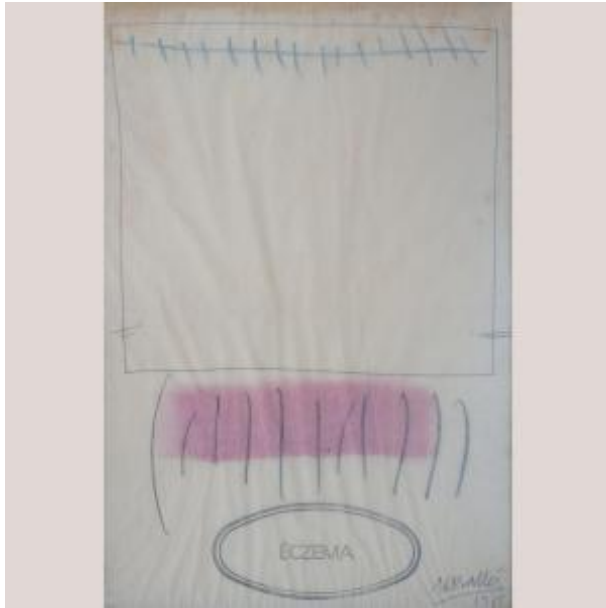

### Description

This mixed media work on paper, presents a restrained composition combining graphite line, muted pink wash, and printed text. The word "Éczema" appears centrally within an oval form, balanced by linear marks and framing elements that give the piece a schematic, almost diagram-like structure. The surface shows gentle undulation and light age-related spotting, consistent with works on paper from the period. The limited palette and controlled mark-making suggest an interest in conceptual or graphic abstraction rather than narrative imagery. Overall, the work reflects late 20th-century experimental practices that merge text, drawing, and minimal color into a measured and deliberate composition.
