18-karat yellow gold necklace, horse's head hallmark. It consists of a stylized chain holding alternating rectangular floral motifs. These foliate motifs are centered with either a diamond or an emerald in a beaded setting. A brooch with a removable pin, set with two emeralds and a diamond, hangs from the chain, terminating in knives adorned with diamonds measuring 0.40 carats each. It detaches to form two bracelets. This piece can therefore be worn as a necklace, brooch, or bracelets. Dimensions: Necklace: 47 cm; Brooch: 5.5 cm x 3.5 cm; Bracelets: 22 cm each. French work, circa 1870, bearing the hallmarks of Violet Victor Adrien
