Meyer-Wiegand depicts a lively British port rendered with realism and quiet nostalgia. Known for his maritime compositions, the artist works with subtle shades of grey, brown and blue, capturing both the reflections of light on the water and the atmosphere of a working harbour. In the foreground, a ship with dark sails draws the eye, its strong silhouette lending depth and structure to the composition. In the background, additional vessels suggest the constant activity of a bustling port. The overcast sky and moving water reinforce the realism of the scene, while conveying a mood that is both vibrant and slightly melancholic.
