



## Quiver

### Description

Quiver (utsubo) made of lacquered and gilded wood; the outside is almost entirely covered in fur (bear? wild boar?) except for the lid which is lacquered black. This type of quiver--which was intended to protect arrows from the elements--was worn horizontally on the right hip. The movable part is known in Japanese as kamado.
