Spectacular bonheur-du-jour in veneer and precious woods. Louis XV style, a high-quality piece attributed to the "Maison Millet" in Paris. The "Maison Millet" was founded in Paris in 1853. A highly talented specialist in the reproduction of 18th-century furniture, Millet produced furniture and bronze art of the highest quality. He received the highest awards, such as the Gold Medal at the Universal Exhibition in Paris in 1889 and the Grand Prix at the Universal Exhibition of 1900. The Maison Millet remained in operation until 1918.
